BZA:

- o Approval was granted on January 23rd at 7pm for the construction of a covered handicap ramp at 4361 Troy Rd.
- Various questions and inquiries
 - O Spoke to Luke Streng, a representative for the Delaware County Humane Society, about the two lots they are in contract with just south of the Coover / 23 intersection (one is 11 acres, and the other is 17 acres). Mike sent him the rezoning request documentation. Luke, members of the Humane Society, and Sabatino attended last week's Zoning meeting and discussed it during the public discussion. They have outgrown their current location. The proposal was well received. It is currently zoned as FR-1, but the future plan shows it to be Commercial. They are currently fundraising for donations.
 - O Received an inquiry about a 20-acre property on Buttermilk Hill Rd. The prospective buyer is interested in dividing the property and constructing a home and a 60x200 pole barn for a Concrete Pump Business. This matter was brought up at the Zoning Commission meeting, but no decision was made on whether it could proceed without changing the zoning from FR-1 to Commercial. Mike was asked to consult with Regional Planning, which he did, resulting in the same status. Richard and Mike will continue to address the request.
